



HANDS-ON SINUS LIFT COURSE

COURSE OVERVIEW

In our Level 2 Advanced Sinus lift surgery course, attendees will enhance their practical skills and expertise by acquiring knowledge on sinus lift techniques and the handling of complications in challenging cases. This will give our candidates a comprehensive overview of managing severely atrophic maxilla.



During this course, we aim for our candidates to develop hands-on knowledge of sinus lift procedures and carry out crestal and lateral approach sinus and bone grafting surgery on patients.

COURSE STRUCTURE

Participants will be working in small groups and performing surgery with the other participant assisting them. This will be done under the supervision of one of our experienced implantologists. In the morning, cases will be discussed before clinical sessions starting late morning. In the evening, we have a review session, with the discussion and feedback for all the candidates.

The course runs for 5 days, during which participants will learn how to assess, plan treatment and surgical approaches to lateral and internal sinus augmentation and carry out 7 sinus lift procedures on the patients.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PRACTICAL IMPLANT EXPERIENCE

To be eligible for practical implant experience, one must have a minimum of 1 year of oral surgery experience and have placed at least 50 implants.

HANDS-ON BONE GRAFTING COURSE

COURSE OVERVIEW

Our Hands-on bone grafting course can be customized to fit your individual learning objectives. This level of the course is designed for participants to gain further practical experience by undertaking challenging and complex soft and hard tissue grafting. These cases may include, but are not limited to, implantation in highly atrophic bone, bone augmentation, intra-oral harvesting of the patient's bone, block grafts, piezo-surgery techniques, ridge splitting techniques, PRF/PRP and the use of titanium mesh in oral reconstruction. Participants will also be exposed to a wide range of cases, including managing complications during implant surgery, performing soft tissue grafting, guided bone regeneration (GBR), bone harvesting, and microsurgery.



COURSE STRUCTURE

Delegates will be working in small group and performing surgery with the other participant assisting them. This will be done under the supervision of one of our experienced implantologists. In the morning, cases will be discussed before clinical sessions starting late morning. In the evening, we have a review session, with the discussion and feedback for all the candidates.

HANDS-ON ALL ON 4/6 COURSE

COURSE OVERVIEW

All-on-4 concept is the placement of 2 tilted implants in the posterior region and 2 straight implants in the anterior region, commonly known as the All-on-4 treatment concept, to rehabilitate the edentulous ridges and was developed to restore patients with a fixed aesthetic and functional prosthesis in as little as one day, while avoiding more complex surgeries such as grafting procedures.



The All-on-4/6 dental implant course is designed to provide dental professionals with the knowledge and skills necessary to perform the All-on-4/6 dental implant procedure. This course will cover the basic principles of implant dentistry, patient selection and assessment, surgical techniques, prosthetic considerations, and post-operative care. Participants will have the opportunity to learn through didactic lectures, case presentations, and hands-on practical sessions on live patients

COURSE STRUCTURE

The All-on-4/6 dental implant course is a comprehensive program that includes both theoretical and practical training. The course is typically conducted over a period of 5 days, with the following structure:

- Introduction to implant dentistry and the All-on-4/6 concept
- Patient selection and assessment
- Surgical principles and techniques
- Live surgery observation
- Prosthetic considerations
- Laboratory procedures
- Live patient treatment planning
- Hands-on practical session on live patients

The hands-on practical sessions will be conducted under the supervision of experienced implant dentists and will provide participants with the opportunity to practice complete four All-on-4/6 cases on live patients.


